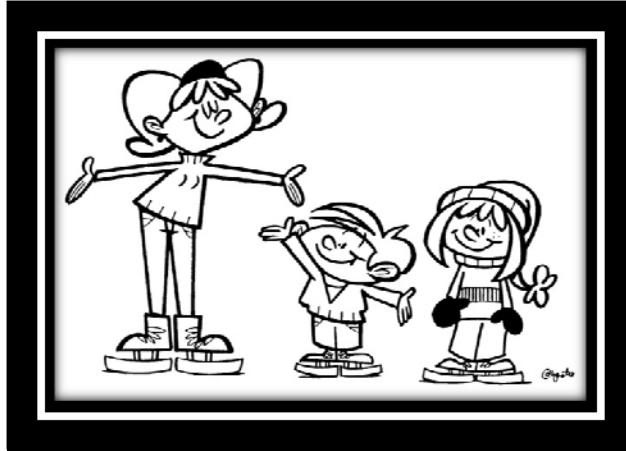


INTRODUCING THE SILVER LEAFS “STUDENT *I*C*E*” PROGRAM

(Student Instructor and Coach Education)



The Leafs Ice Centre is proud to announce a new program designed to educate and train skaters that wish to become figure skating instructors and coaches.

Just because you know *how* to skate does not mean you know *how to teach* someone else to skate. Most rinks around the country now require potential instructors/coaches to have formal training and experience before they will be hired or allowed to teach at their facility.

This newly offered training program will thoroughly cover what a new instructor needs to know to become successful in the area of figure skating education.

Program Outline

- Weekly classroom lessons and assignments
- On ice instruction
- Weekly observations of current skating classes
- Mentoring with current instructors
- Content and technique at both ISI and USFS levels
- Video presentations

Program will coincide with our skate school sessions and will be 8 weeks in length. Program is divided into levels with one level being covered per session. Levels must be completed in natural progression. Upon completion of a session, participant will be given an evaluation, certificate of completion and potential opportunity for employment teaching at the levels which have been completed. Entrance into the program and advancement through levels will be at the discretion of the Figure Skating Director.

Pre-registration is required **Prerequisite: At least 16 years of age and passed ISI FS 1 level**
